N. Anderson to S. H. Hanauer. You proposed, in your letter of April 11, 1980, to complete installation of the ATWS modification in the fall of 1982.

The date for completing ATWS modifications recommended by the staff in NUREG-0460, Volume 4, was July 1, 1981. As a result of public comments, we are considering extension of this date. However, we would like Indian Point, because of the risk we believe it represents, to improve upon the schedule required of other plants. With this in mind, re-evaluate your original proposal and submit, within 30 days of receipt of this letter, a revised schedule and justification for this schedule.
