Subject: Submittal of NAC Responses to UMS-MY RAI-1

Based on the news reports here, I think the federal agencies were out yesterday and will be out today due to the snowy weather. Please respond when your schedule permits. Thank you.

1. Based on the current status of the preparation of the NAC Responses to the UMS-MY RAI-1 as reported by the Project Engineer/Manager and the projected schedule for final licensing review followed by the NAC QA review, NAC is planning to submit the RAI-1 Responses by FAX on Friday, February 4, and express-ship the "hard" copies of the responses and the SAR Changed Pages for delivery on the morning of Monday, February 7, 2000. I believe that this will meet the intent of the NRC requested 45-day turnaround on the responses. Please advise whether this schedule for the submittal will meet the NRC's needs to support continuing review of the MY amendment. Thank you.

2. As a heads-up for your information, Ed Davis (NAC President and CEO) has meetings scheduled with three, and possibly four, of the NRC Commissioners on Wednesday, February 2, 2000. I don't know the planned topics of the meetings, but I expect these to be higher-level discussions of the licensing process, industry (especially NAC) support of the objectives of the process, and the need for continued staffing of the SFPO, among others.
