Subject: Direct Final for NAC-UMS Maine Yankee

TSSI folks and other interested parties:

Completion of the NAC-UMS Maine Yankee amendment review is being rescheduled. A revised schedule is in concurrence as we speak. The new schedule (not approved yet) will reflect applicant response to RAI #2 by 7/31/00, with a proposed CoC/SER to be issued to commence rulemaking by 10/3/00.

Bill Brach conveyed to me this amendment should be direct final. I believe this viewpoint may well extend as a default for most amendment, always having the proposed rulemaking as a fall-back position. SFPO management will probably convey this in the near future.

However, for the NAC-UMS Maine Yankee review, I hereby request that the appropriate steps be taken to pursue the rulemaking aspects as a **direct final**, with the parallel proposed rulemaking package.
