Nordion F-257: Meeting notice should have gone out for May 3 at 9 a.m. I will call Melissa Mann of TLI when I know the notice is out (I have left her a message that the notice should be going out), just to confirm they know, and all the players listed on the notice are coming (I consider everyone on the notice that is not NRC her responsibility). We will also need to re-establish a new approval date for this, through DOE and the public meeting I would imagine. It has gotten way off track since it took so long for them to respond.
