Subject: Call from NAC

I rec'd a call from NAC (Ed Davis) late yesterday informing me that Davis will be calling Bill Kane to raise a concern about SFPO's introducing new criteria and raising issues not here to fore raised in cask reviews, as included in the June 2000 UMS (MY) amendment RAI. The two issues involve the cask loading assurance and variable radial enrichment. I talked to Kane late yesterday and Davis had already left a message for Kane to return the call . I told Kane we would provide him background on the matter. We will need to pull together background material to give Kane the question we asked, why it was appropriate and our technical basis for asking the question. I would like to review this information with you later this morning.

During the call to me, Davis also raised a concern about receiving the RAI and the change in schedule. On these last two points I informed Davis of our earlier conference calls and the NAC letter to us asking us to include the April amendment in our review with the understanding of the resultant change in schedule. On the last two points, Davis told me he would check his information and call me back on Thursday. Bill
