MOTION FOR ADJUSTMENT OF SCHEDULE

The Memorandum and Order (Supplemental Filing Schedules and Procedures), dated December 5, 2000, stated that any responses and questions relating to information set forth in the Staff's Safety Evaluation Reports in this proceeding ("SER") should be included in the parties' written responses to direct testimony, rebuttal testimony and proposed questions, scheduled to be filed by January 16, 2001. The Power Authority of the State of New York, Entergy Nuclear FitzPatrick, LLC, Entergy Nuclear Indian Point, LLC and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. hereby request that the Presiding Officer modify the schedule so that any responses and questions relating to information in the SER be filed with the parties' written statements of position and written direct testimony to be filed by December 27, 2000.

The December 5 Memorandum and Order indicates that all parties have the SER. Therefore, it should not be a burden to include in the December 27 filings any responses to the information set forth in the SER. Requiring that this information be included in the


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December 27 filings will allow other parties to address those responses in their January 16, 2001 submittals. Under the current schedule, the parties would not have the opportunity to address other parties' positions on the SER, other than by proposed questions directed to written rebuttal testimony (scheduled for submittal by January 26, 2001).

For these reasons, we respectfully submit that the Presiding Officer modify the schedule set forth in the December 5, 2000 Memorandum and Order to require that any responses and questions relating to information set forth in the SER be included in the submittal of written statements of position and written direct testimony scheduled for December 27, 2000.

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
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
