Dear Mr. Chamberlain:

Please accept this letter as an official request to rephrase our previously granted exemption of 11/5/99. Recently Mr. Richard Leonardi, Jr. performed an audit of our activities in federal jurisdiction. During his audit, he pointed out a few specific requirements of the exemption. In further review of these issues, it appears that item 8 is stated different than my original interpretation. It states that we shall conduct radiation surveys before, during, and after each exposure and they shall be recorded. This statement is partially correct. Surveys are made at these intervals on normal activities, however recording each survey is cumbersome. We would like to request your consideration of rephrasing this statement by removing the words "and recorded" from item #8. The current survey reports we utilize in all radioactive activities are included for your review. We do record survey results before any shift begins, before and after breaks (lunch, etc.), and at completion of the shift.
