COMMENTS ON PRIORITIZATION OF GENERIC SAFETY ISSUE (GSI) 156.6.1:
"PIPE BREAK EFFECTS ON SYSTEMS AND COMPONENTS INSIDE CONTAINMENT"

This letter is to document the agreed upon response date for comments on draft NUREG/CR-6395, "Enhanced Prioritization of Generic Safety Issue 156-6.1 Pipe Break Effects on Systems and Components Inside Containment (Draft)."
