SUBJECT: SUPPLEMENT 1 TO NUREG-0737, REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION OF
COMMISSION ORDER DATED FEBRUARY 21, 1984.

By letter dated August 19, 1985, you requested that we extend the completion date for Item 2.b dealing with the Detailed Control Room Design Review (DCRDR) contained in the Commission Order dated February 21, 1984, relating to Supplement 1 to NUREG-0737 for Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3. The Commission Order allows an extension of time to be granted by the Director, Division of Licensing, for good cause shown.

In your August 19, 1985, submittal you requested that the submittal date of the summary report on DCRDR (Item 2.b of our Confirmatory Order) be extended from the Cycle 4/5 refueling outage to October 31, 1985. The plant is now in the Cycle 4/5 refueling outage and it is estimated that startup would be in September 1985.

The October 31, 1985 is the date that you had anticipated startup from the Cycle 4/5 refueling outage but refueling occurred earlier than originally planned. We agree that this date is acceptable and that you have shown a good faith effort. Therefore, in accordance with the terms of the February 21, 1984 Commission Order, we conclude that there is adequate justification for modification of the Commission's Order and hereby grant the extension of Item 2.b from Cycle 4/5 refueling outage to October 31, 1985.

A copy of the revised Table which was included with the Commission's Order is enclosed.
