Gentlemen:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 13 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-64 for the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your application dated September 1, 1977, revised by letters dated October 18, 1977, December 12, 1977, January 30, 1978 and February 2, 1978. Revisions to your proposed changes, as discussed with and agreed to by your staff, have been made to meet Regulatory requirements.

The amendment authorizes modifications to the Indian Point Unit No. 3 spent fuel pool, increasing its capacity from 264 to 840 fuel assemblies, and revises the Technical Specifications appropriately.

Copies of the Safety Evaluation, Environmental Impact Appraisal and the Notice of Issuance/Negative Declaration are also enclosed.

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
  - A. The application for amendment by Power Authority of the State of New York (the licensee) sworn to September 1, 1977, as supplemented by letters dated October 18, 1977, December 12, 1977, January 30, 1978, and February 2, 1978, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
  - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the application, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
  - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
  - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
  - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.


2. Accordingly, the license is amended by changes to the Technical Specifications as indicated in the attachment to this license amendment, and paragraph 2.C.(2) of Facility Operating License No. DPR-64 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) Technical Specifications

The Technical Specifications contained in Appendices A and B, as revised through Amendment No. 13, are hereby incorporated in the license. The licensee shall operate the facility in accordance with the Technical Specifications.

3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance.
