The Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3) Environmental Protection Plan (EPP), Appendix B of the CR-3 Operating License, establishes reporting requirements related to the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. Section 3.2.3 of the EPP requires that NRC be provided with copies of changes to the NPDES permit.

A minor NPDES permit revision was granted to allow continued use of chemical additives in the Instrument Air Compressors by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (see attachment).
