We represent Kaiser Aluminum & Chemical Corporation, one of the defendants in the above-captioned lawsuit. I am writing in follow-up to my telephone conversation with you this afternoon, Thursday, December 21, 2000. Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, and in connection with the above referenced litigation, we request the following Atomic Energy Commission ("AEC") and Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") documents generated in connection with the possession and use of nuclear materials and special nuclear materials by U.S. Steel at its facilities in Duquesne, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania:

all letters and supporting documents submitted by U.S. Steel to the AEC/NRC to apply for, renew, and amend licenses for *U.S. Steel, as licensee*, to possess and use radioactive materials in Duquesne, Pennsylvania;

all licenses, including amendments and renewals, issued by the AEC/NRC to *U.S. Steel, as licensee*, authorizing the possession and use of radioactive materials in Duquesne, Pennsylvania;

all letters and supporting documents submitted by U.S. Steel to the AEC/NRC for permission to take possession of, and use nuclear materials and/or special nuclear materials, *under general license*, at its facilities in Duquesne, Pennsylvania;

all general licenses, including amendments and renewals, issued by the AEC/NRC, under which U.S. Steel possessed and used nuclear materials, and/or special nuclear materials, at its facilities in Duquesne, Pennsylvania;

all records of inspections by the AEC/NRC of U.S. Steel facilities in Duquesne, PA; and,

all records relating to AEC or NRC violations identified at U.S. Steel facilities in Duquesne, Pennsylvania.
