SUBJECT: ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT FOR INDIAN POINT NUCLEAR GENERATING
UNIT NO. 3 (TAC NO. M88043)

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 141 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-64 for the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications (TSs) in response to your application transmitted by letter dated October 19, 1993.

The amendment revises TS 6.5.2.2 to change the membership of the Safety Review Committee (SRC). The proposed amendment also modifies TS 6.5.2.10 to change the time limit for providing the Executive Vice President - Nuclear Generation with SRC meeting minutes and reports of review.

A copy of the related Safety Evaluation is enclosed. A Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's next regular biweekly Federal Register notice.

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

License No. DPR-64

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
 - A. The application for amendment by Power Authority of the State of New York (the licensee) dated October 19, 1993, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act) and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
 - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the application, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
 - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
 - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
 - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
2. Accordingly, the license is amended by changes to the Technical Specifications as indicated in the attachment to this license amendment, and paragraph 2.C.(2) of Facility Operating License No. DPR-64 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) Technical Specifications

The Technical Specifications contained in Appendices A and B, as revised through Amendment No. 141, are hereby incorporated in the license. The licensee shall operate the facility in accordance with the Technical Specifications.

3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance to be implemented within 30 days.

MEMBERSHIP

6.5.2.2 The SRC shall be composed of the following voting members:

Chairman:	Manager-Nuclear Safety Evaluation
Vice-Chairman:	Vice President - Appraisal and Compliance Services
Member:	Vice President-Nuclear Operations
Member:	Vice President-Nuclear Engineering
Member:	Resident Manager - IP3
Member:	Resident Manager - JAF
Member:	Consultant
Member:	Consultant

ALTERNATES

6.5.2.3 All alternate members shall be appointed in writing by the SRC Chairman. An Alternate Vice-Chairman shall be appointed in writing by the Executive Vice President-Nuclear Generation if necessary. However, no more than two alternates shall participate as voting members in SRC activities at any one time.

CONSULTANTS

6.5.2.4 Consultants shall be utilized as determined by the SRC Chairman to provide expert advice to the SRC.

MEETING FREQUENCY

6.5.2.5 The SRC shall meet at least once per calendar quarter during the initial year of facility operation following initial fuel loading and at least once per six months, thereafter.

QUORUM

6.5.2.6 A quorum of SRC shall consist of the Chairman or Vice-Chairman or Alternate Vice-Chairman and four members, including alternates. No more than a minority of the quorum shall have direct line responsibility for the operation of the plant.

- l. The OFFSITE DOSE CALCULATION MANUAL and implementing procedures at least once per 24 months.
- m. The PROCESS CONTROL PROGRAM and implementing procedures for processing and packaging of radioactive wastes at least once per 24 months.

AUTHORITY

6.5.2.9 The SRC shall report to and advise the Executive Vice President-Nuclear Generation on those areas of responsibility specified in Sections 6.5.2.7 and 6.5.2.8.

RECORDS

6.5.2.10 Records will be maintained in accordance with ANSI 18.7-1972. The following shall be prepared and distributed as indicated below:

- a. Minutes of each SRC meeting shall be prepared and forwarded to the Executive Vice President-Nuclear Generation within 30 days after the date of the meeting.
- b. Reports of reviews encompassed by Section 6.5.2.7 above shall be prepared and forwarded to the Executive Vice President-Nuclear Generation within 30 days following completion of the review.
- c. Audit reports encompassed by Section 6.5.2.8 above, shall be forwarded to the Executive Vice President-Nuclear Generation and to the management positions responsible for the areas audited within 30 days after the completion of the audit.

CHARTER

6.5.2.11 Conduct of the committee will be in accordance with a charter, approved by the Executive Vice President-Nuclear Generation, setting forth the mechanism for implementation of the committee's responsibilities and authority.

6.6 REPORTABLE EVENT ACTION

6.6.1 The following actions shall be taken for REPORTABLE EVENTS:

- a. The Commission shall be notified and a report submitted pursuant to the requirements of Section 50.73 to 10 CFR Part 50, and

1.0 INTRODUCTION

By letter dated October 19, 1993, the Power Authority of the State of New York (the licensee) submitted a request for changes to the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3 (IP3) Technical Specifications (TSs). The requested changes would modify the membership of the Safety Review Committee (SRC) described in TS 6.5.2.2 and modify TS 6.5.2.10 to change record keeping requirements.

2.0 EVALUATION

The licensee has proposed revisions to TS 6.5.2.2 that would revise the membership of the SRC to reflect the recent organizational change at the licensee's corporate office. In addition, the SRC record preparation and distribution requirements would also change TS 6.5.2.10 to be consistent with NUREG-1431, "Westinghouse Standard Technical Specifications" (WSTS).

One portion of the proposed amendment to TS 6.5.2.2 is a result of an organizational change within the licensee's corporate office which eliminated the position of Vice President - Nuclear Support (VP-NS). The groups previously reporting to the VP-NS will now report to the Vice President - Nuclear Operations (VP-NO). The interests of those groups previously reporting to the VP-NS will continue to be represented because the VP-NO is already assigned as an SRC member. Replacement of the Director - Quality Assurance with the Vice President - Appraisal and Compliance Services as a member and SRC Vice Chairman would elevate quality assurance representation on the SRC and establish SRC membership at a more uniform management level. The proposed change in membership would put all SRC members, except consultants and the SRC Chairman, at the vice president level.

In addition to the changes in membership, the licensee proposed a change in TS 6.5.2.10 concerning record keeping requirements. The time limit for providing the Executive Vice President - Nuclear Generation with SRC meeting minutes and reports would change from 14 days to 30 days. This change is consistent with the WSTS.

The staff has reviewed the above proposed changes and has concluded that they are acceptable since they are administrative in nature and do not involve any changes that would reduce plant safety.

3.0 STATE CONSULTATION

In accordance with the Commission's regulations, the New York State official was notified of the proposed issuance of the amendment. The State official had no comments.

4.0 ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATION

The amendment relates to changes in administrative procedures and requirements. Accordingly, the amendment meets the eligibility criteria for categorical exclusion set forth in 10 CFR 51.22(c)(10). Pursuant to 10 CFR 51.22(b) no environmental impact statement or environmental assessment need be prepared in connection with the issuance of the amendment.

5.0 CONCLUSION

The Commission has concluded, based on the considerations discussed above, that: (1) there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by operation in the proposed manner, (2) such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations, and (3) the issuance of the amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public.
