AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

License No. DPR-64

1. Pursuant to a Decision of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board dated October 12, 1977, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission has amended Facility Operating License DPR-64 as follows:

Paragraph 2.C.(4)(c) is revised in its entirety to read:


Determination of the relationship of current and historic earthquake activity to the Ramapo Fault and Ramapo Fault System.

The last paragraph of 2.C.(4) is revised in its entirety to read:

The licensees shall provide a detailed work plan for completion of the above studies within sixty days from the date of issuance of this license amendment. The investigations under Conditions (a), (b) and (d) shall be completed and a final report of the findings submitted to the Commission for review by April 1, 1977.

2. This amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance.

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has, pursuant to the Decision of its Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board dated October 12, 1977, issued Amendment No. 9 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-64, issued to the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. and the Power Authority of the State of New York (the licensees), for the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Station Unit No. 3 (the facility) located in Westchester County, New York. The amendment is effective as of its date of issuance.

The amendment deletes the license requirement for installation of an expanded microseismic monitoring network.


