SUBJECT: SECY-91-022 - TASK FORCE ON PILGRIM OFFSITE
EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

The Commission (with all Commissioners agreeing) has approved the staff's plan of action for the Pilgrim Emergency Preparedness (EP) Task Force subject to the following comments:

- o The staff should closely coordinate its efforts with those of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in order to minimize the possibility of both agencies issuing significantly different evaluation reports.
- o Prior to holding a public meeting to solicit comments on the draft Task Force report, the staff should discuss the preliminary findings in the draft report with the public officials responsible for offsite emergency planning.
- o In light of the Inspector General's earlier criticism that the Lessons Learned Task Force did not address the full scope of the issues in its mandate, the current Task Force should clearly address, in format and content, the tasks assigned in its charter, and should fully describe the facts and other considerations underlying its findings and recommendations.
- o The Task Force should document in detail the process and procedures employed in this review so that they may be used in any future activity of this type.
