

Gentlemen:

We hereby apply for an amendment to our Byproduct Material License Number 12-140-4 (G65) with regard to the possession limit for Krypton-85. Our present license has a possession limit of one curie for this isotope. Our use of this material has expanded so that it seems desirable to raise the possession limit to 20 curies of Krypton-85.

The present amount of Krypton-85 on hand and unused is 2.02 curies, which is above the possession limit covered by our present license. This overage represents no safety hazard. This is the only isotope which exceeds the possession limits of this license. This overage should have been detected at the time of purchase of this material. We are taking positive measures to insure that such an overage does not recur.
