The Commission\* was briefed by the NRC staff on the proposed rule for training and qualification of nuclear power plant personnel.

The Commission expressed a number of concerns over the broad scope of the rule as prepared by the staff. In particular, the staff should consider whether the general approach taken in sections 6.1 through 6.7 of the ANSI standard coupled with the NUREG would be sufficient from a technical standpoint and OGC should determine whether it would satisfy the court mandate.
