

Dear Sir/Madam:

In the Reference 1 letter, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission approved the relief requests associated with the Second Ten-Year Interval Inservice Testing (IST) Program for Limerick Generating Station (LGS), Units 1 and 2. In that letter, the Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2 IST Program was identified as starting on January 8, 2000, and concluding on January 7, 2010. In the Reference 2 letter, the start date for the Second Ten-Year Interval was identified as January 8, 2000. However, this start date was later revised to August 8, 2000 as discussed in the Reference 3 letter. The purpose of this letter is to clarify that the start date for the LGS, Units 1 and 2 Second Ten-Year Interval IST Program is August 8, 2000, and will conclude on January 7, 2010.
