Dear Mr. Sletten:

This is in response to your letter dated December 18, 2000, requesting to deactivate NR-0154-D-101-S registration certificate for dual energy gamma ray gauge Model DEG.

In order for this registration certificate to be transferred to inactive status, please provide the following information:

1. The total number of the products sold and the number of products still in use;
2. The service (including source replacement and availability) the registration certificate holder will still provide to the users of the product or the identification of an entity that will provide services;
3. A commitment that the registration certificate holder will no longer commercially distribute the product; and
4. Verification that no changes were made to the product since its initial registration or last amendment.
