SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS THE RESULTS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW OF ARKANSAS NUCLEAR ONE, UNIT 1

On Tuesday, November 14, 2000, members of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held public meetings in Russellville, Arkansas, to discuss the results of the environmental review performed in support of the Arkansas Nuclear One, Unit 1 (ANO-1) license renewal application. Two sessions were held to allow maximum public participation. Formal presentations were made by several members of the NRC staff. Attachments 1 and 2 are the transcripts recorded at both meetings. Attachment 3 is a copy of the slide presentation, and Attachment 4 is a list of attendees for both the 1:30 pm and 7:00 pm sessions.

The purpose of the meetings was to describe the results of the staff's environmental review of ANO-1 and to provide the public an opportunity to provide any comments they might have on Supplement 3 to NUREG-1437, "Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Power Plants," which summarizes the staff's review of ANO-1. The staff presentations outlined the overall license renewal process; provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) review process; discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51; and described the results of the environmental review. The presenters also explained how to submit comments regarding the document to the NRC.

After the formal presentations given by the NRC staff, a representative from Entergy Operations, Inc. addressed the audience, providing comments supporting renewal of the license. Next, members of the public were invited to provide comments. Approximately 35 people attended the two sessions. No other comments were presented during the meeting. Attendees included representatives of the NRC, Entergy Operations Inc., the nuclear industry, State agencies, the press, and members of the public.
