SUBJECT: ADMINISTRATION OF THE STARS PROGRAM

Dear Mr. Passwater:

A number of discussions have been held between representatives of the STARS organization (a cooperative effort among a number of nuclear power plant licensees) and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff. These discussions include meetings on August 16 and November 9, 2000, and a December 8, 2000, telephone conversation between yourself and Mr. D. Jaffe of the NRC staff. The NRC staff believes that it can achieve organizational efficiencies in a manner similar to those achieved by STARS in responding to STARS initiatives. The NRC will continue to respond to STARS initiatives with plant-specific licensing actions. We will designate a STARS Project Manager (PM) for each STARS initiative. The STARS PM will act as the NRC staff's focal point for response to STARS-initiated licensing actions and will work directly with the NRC staff's assigned plant PMs and Project Directorate IV Section Chiefs, to provide plant-specific responses to the STARS initiatives. The STARS PM will be designated after receipt of notification of a new STARS initiative. Mr. D. Jaffe is designated as the STARS PM for the "Technical Specifications Bases Control Program" initiative, and Mr. J. Donohew will continue to be the contact point for discussions concerning administrative matters between STARS and the NRC staff.
