On September 13, 2000, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued License Amendment 193 to Florida Power Corporation (FPC) which increased the licensed capacity of spent fuel storage in the Spent Fuel Pool at Crystal River Unit 3. By letter dated October 26, 2000, FPC informed us of clarifications and corrections required to the Safety Evaluation (SE) accompanying License No. Amendment No. 193, along with updates and clarifications to License Amendment Request No. 239.
