I. SECY-91-336 - Appeal of LBP-91-28, Public Service Company of
New Hampshire, et al. (Transfer of Ownership Amendment)

The Commission, by a 4-0 vote, approved an order responding to a June 28, 1991, appeal from LBP-91-28, by the Seacoast Anti-Pollution League. The Licensing Board's decision denies a petition by SAPL for leave to intervene on a proposed amendment to the operating license for the Seabrook station.

The Commission's Order dismissed the appeal due to SAPL's failure to submit its brief on time and otherwise affirmed the Licensing Board's decision.

(Subsequently, on November 15, 1991, the Secretary signed the Order.)

II. SECY-91-330 - Final Rule on Nuclear Power Plant License
Renewal

The Commission, by a 4-0 vote, approved a final rule on nuclear power plant license renewal as modified on the attached pages.

The Commission also considered requests from the UCS (Diane Curran) and NIRS (Michael Mariotte) to reissue the license renewal rule for public comment and decided not to do so.

The staff should monitor carefully the experience of the first few plants under this rule, and on the basis of a lessons learned assessment, consider modifications to further improve the rule in the future.
