ORDER

The Board will follow the order of presentation and the time allocations set forth below:

Standing: Oncavage 5 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 5 minutes each;
Mr. Oncavage 3 minutes rebuttal.

Oncavage contention 1: Mr. Oncavage 10 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 5 minutes each; Mr. Oncavage 3 minutes rebuttal.

Oncavage contention 2: Mr. Oncavage 20 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 10 minutes each; Mr. Oncavage 5 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 1: Ms. Lorion 10 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 5 minutes each;
Ms. Lorion 5 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 2: Ms. Lorion 15 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 10 minutes each; Ms. Lorion 5 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 3: Ms. Lorion 5 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 5 minutes each; Ms. Lorion 3 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 4: Ms. Lorion 15 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 10 minutes each; Ms. Lorion 5 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 5: Ms. Lorion 10 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 5 minutes each; Ms. Lorion 5 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 6: Ms. Lorion 10 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 5 minutes each; Ms. Lorion 3 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 7: Ms. Lorion 5 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 3 minutes each; Ms. Lorion 3 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 8: Ms. Lorion 10 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 5 minutes each; Ms. Lorion 3 minutes rebuttal.

Lorion contention 9: Ms. Lorion 10 minutes; Applicant and NRC Staff 5 minutes each; Ms. Lorion 3 minutes rebuttal.

In making their presentations, the Participants are free to use less than their allotted time and they should assume that the Licensing Board members are fully familiar with the Participants' various filings. Finally, the Petitioners should focus their respective presentations on the applicable arguments of the Applicant and the Staff set forth in their filings.
