SUBJECT: CORRECTION TO AMENDMENTS, SUSQUEHANNA STEAM ELECTRIC STATION, UNITS
1 AND 2 (TAC NOS. M91013 AND M91014)

Dear Mr. Byram:

On August 15, 1995, the Commission issued Amendment No. 151 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-14 and Amendment No. 121 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-22 for the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2. These amendments deleted reference to the main steamline isolation valve (MSIV) leakage control system and its associated primary containment isolation valves, and increased the allowable leakage rate for any MSIV and the total maximum pathway leakage for all four main steam lines. In the staff's safety evaluation supporting the amendment approval, Figures 1-3 were listed in the text on pages 18 and 19. Due to an administrative oversight, these three figures, which were developed by Commission staff, were omitted from the safety evaluation which we sent to you. I am enclosing a copy of these figures which should be added to your copy of the amendment package.

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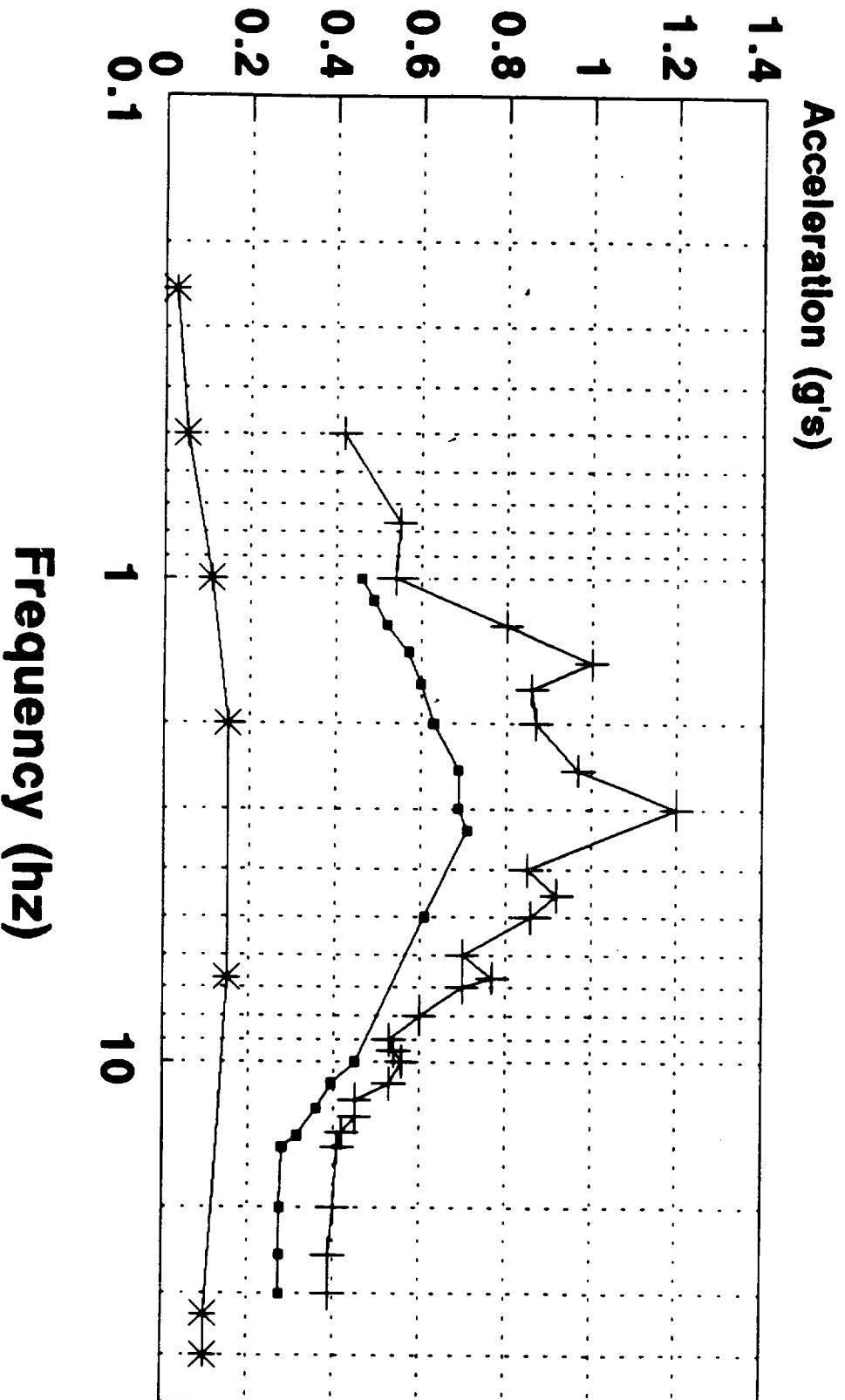

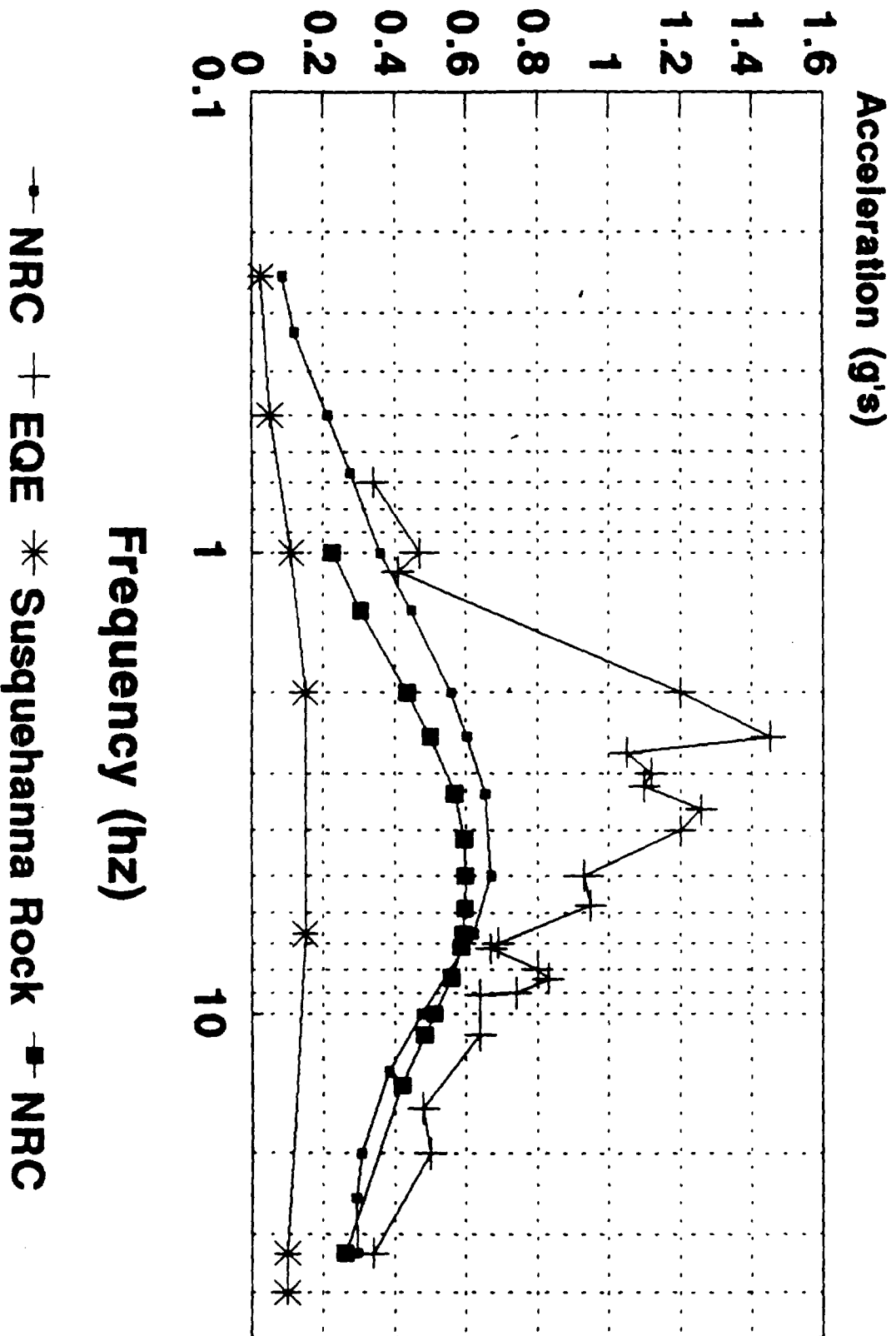

Cape Mendocino 92 PALCO Co-Gen



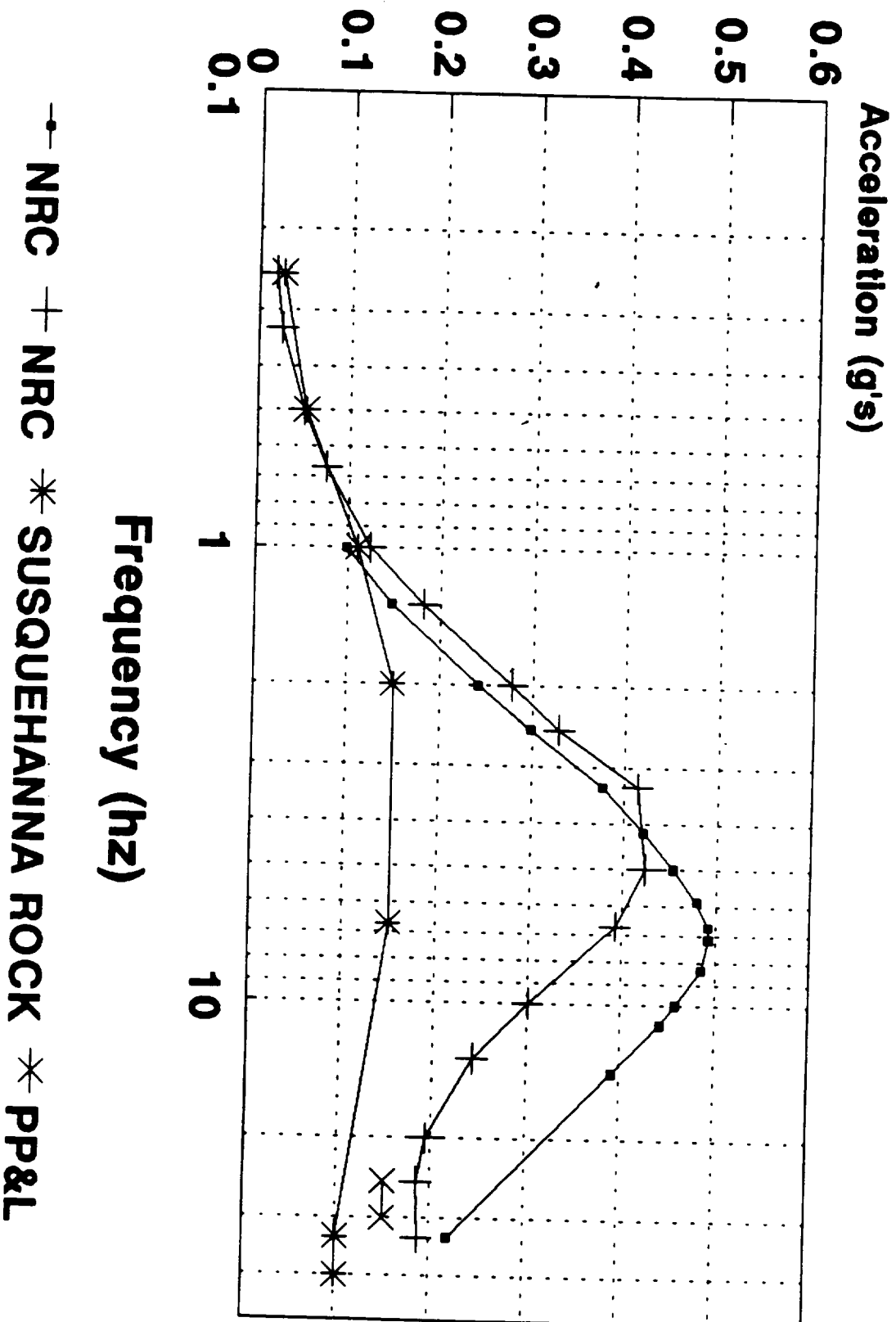
