SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF SCOPING MEETING HELD IN SUPPORT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW FOR THE TURKEY POINT UNITS 3 AND 4 LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION (TAC NOS. MA9940 AND MA9944)

On Wednesday, December 6, 2000, members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held public environmental scoping meetings in Homestead, Florida in support of the staff's review of the application submitted by Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) for renewal of the operating licenses for its Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 (Turkey Point). Afternoon and evening sessions were held to allow maximum public participation. Formal presentations were made by Cynthia Carpenter, Christopher Grimes, and James Wilson, all of the NRC staff. Attachment 1 is a corrected transcript for both meetings. Attachment 2 is a copy of the presentation slides. Attachment 3 is a list of attendees for both the 1:30 pm and 7:00 pm sessions.

The purpose of the meetings was to provide the public with an opportunity to participate in the environmental scoping process by providing comments on any issues that it thought the NRC staff should consider while preparing a plant-specific supplement to the "Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants" (NUREG-1437) for Turkey Point. The staff presentations outlined the overall license renewal process, provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act review process, discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51, and addressed how these requirements would be implemented during the Turkey Point license renewal review.

After the formal presentations given by the NRC staff, officials from FPL were given the opportunity to address the audience and provide comments focusing on the environmental report that was submitted as part of the license renewal application. Next, members of the public were invited to provide comments. More than 80 people attended the two sessions with several dozen making comments. Attendees included representatives of the NRC, FPL, and nuclear industry; local government officials; State agency officials; special interest groups, and other members of the public.
