



NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF THE
NUCLEAR GENERATION EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION

The Nuclear Generation Employees Association ("NGEA") does hereby voluntarily and with prejudice withdraw from this proceeding and hereby withdraws its Request for Hearing and Petition for Leave to Intervene on all issues. NGEA lacks the financial resources to prosecute properly the issues for which it was granted intervention and, although efforts have been made to secure additional financial resources, those efforts have been unsuccessful. Accordingly, although NGEA believes the issues it has raised in this proceeding have substantial merit and should be heard by the Presiding Officer, NGEA is forced to withdraw. Likewise, the applicants in this proceeding were unwilling to assist NGEA with settlement of the issues it has raised, and were unwilling to assist NGEA with payment of legal fees.


