By letter dated February 17, 1999, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Amendment No. 154 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-22 for the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Unit 2. This amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications (TSs) in response to your application dated August 4, 1998, as supplemented by letters dated December 16, 1998, January 12, 1999, and January 28, 1999.

This amendment modified the references in TS Section 5.6.5 of a critical power correlation applicable to Siemans Power Corporation Atrium-10 fuel and included a revised minimum critical power ratio safety limit in TS Section 2.1.1.2.

Your August 4, 1998, letter requested that the TS changes be effective as of its date of issuance and be implemented upon startup following the Unit 2 ninth refueling and inspection outage. The amendment was dated February 17, 1999, and incorrectly stated that implementation will be within 30 days after its date of issuance.
