I. SECY-90-346 - Intervenor's Motion to Reopen the Record in  
Seabrook and .to Shutdown the Reactor

The Commission ' by a 2-0 vote,\* approved an order denying the motion to reopen the record in Seabrook. Commissioner Curtiss did not participate in this action. Commissioner Remick abstained.

The Commission was asked to respond to a motion requesting that the Seabrook proceeding be reopened for further evidentiary hearings on allegedly inadequate staffing for the New Hampshire Radiological Emergency Response Plan. The motion also sought an immediate shutdown of the reactor due to the alleged inadequacy. (Subsequently, on October 26, 1990, the Secretary signed the Order.)
