ORDER

Upon consideration of the State's Memorandum In Support of Motion for a Permanent Injunction Prohibiting Further Operations by Neutron Products Inc. under its 01 License, good cause having been shown, it is by the Court this 3 day of

November 2000, ORDERED that Neutron Products, Inc. shall:

1. Cease and desist from conducting any activities under License No. MD-31-025-01 (the "01 License") with regard to any radioisotopes, including cobalt-60, cesium-137, radium-226, or atomic numbers 3-92 except for the continued possession and storage of material presently on the site. Prohibited activities include, but are not limited to:

a. All phases of cobalt-60 source production, calibration, and distribution,

b. Use or removal of any radioisotope currently located in the limited access area (LAA),

c. Transfer of radioactive sources from the LAA to the irradiators by any means, and



d. Otherwise receiving, using, transferring or acquiring any radioactive material except as specifically approved by the Department.

2. Neutron's continued possession and storage of radioactive material shall be in full compliance with all of the current and future requirements of the applicable statutes and regulations and with the provisions of the current 01 License.

3. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing, Neutron shall ship waste in accordance with the provisions of its 01 License.
