
**Radiation Safety Resume

II-VI Incorporated**

Mr. Nanney has been responsible for assisting in the oversight of the Radiation Safety Program for II-VI Incorporated's licensed activities, managed under USNRC License STA-1455. This license covers the possession and use of both source material and sealed sources.

These responsibilities include reviewing the use of Thorium Oxide and Thorium Fluoride from a safety aspect. Storage, handling and processing of these materials has exceeded 40 mCi.

In addition he has inventoried, and trained on the safe use of sealed sources (including Mn54, Co60, Kr85, Sr90, Cd109, I129, Ba133, Cs 137 and Am241) in our eV Products operation. These sources vary greatly in activity from less than 1 microcurie to 12 millicuries.

These statements were prepared December 15, 2000 at the request of the USNRC for the processing of an amendment to USNRC License STA-1455 (Control Number 128496).
