SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JANUARY 16, 2001, MEETING WITH ELECTRIC
POWER RESEARCH INSTITUTE TO DISCUSS REPORT
TR-102323-R2, "GUIDELINES FOR ELECTROMAGNETIC
INTERFERENCE TESTING IN POWER PLANTS"

On January 16, 2001, the Electric Power Research Institute's (EPRI) Electromagnetic Interference (EMI) Working Group met with the members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) staff to discuss EPRI's report TR-102323-R2, "Guidelines for Electromagnetic Interference Testing in Power Plants," dated November 2000. The purpose of the meeting was to provide the NRC staff with an overview of Revision 2 of TR-102323 before it is submitted to the NRC; it is expected to be submitted by February 2, 2001. Attached is a list of the meeting attendees. The slides presented during the meeting are available under ADAMS accession number ML010180347.

Revision 2 changes the recommended test requirements as a result of knowledge obtained since EPRI published Revision 1 in 1995. Revision 2 also updates certain standards endorsed in TR-102323; for example, Military Standard 461 and 462D have been replaced by Military Standard 461E and International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) 801 Series have been replaced by IEC 61000-4.
