Private Fuel Storage L.L.C., the applicant for the proposed Independent Fuel Storage Installation to be built on the Skull Valley Goshute Indian Reservation in Toelle County, Utah, submits the following comments on possible locations for the NRC's local public document room (LPDR) for the proposed facility.

Because the proposed facility is to be located in Toelle County, we believe that an LPDR should be located within the County. We understand that the Toelle County Commissioners have requested that an LPDR be located in the Toelle Public Library. We support that request.

We are also aware that the Utah Department of Environmental Quality, in a letter dated April 28, 1997 to the Deputy Director of NRC's Spent Fuel Project Office, suggested that the Marriott Library Special Collections section at the University of Utah in Salt Lake City would be a good choice for the LPDR. We have no objection to a second LPDR located at the University of Utah.
