
Dear Mr./Ms. Shum:

I would like to express my strong opposition to allowing nuclear waste to be stored anywhere in Utah, especially in the Skull Valley Indian reservation. I do not believe that the storage would only be temporary (nobody else wants it either, so I doubt it will be leaving here any time soon), and we all agree that this site is not safe even for temporary storage (among other things, there's too much chance for environmental events such as earthquakes and flooding). The site is also too close to the internationally recognized Great Salt Lake ecosystem.

Please deny the request for permission to store nuclear waste in Skull Valley. I understand the needs of the Goshute people for an economic boost. This is not the way. It would be better to build a college in their area than to subject them to the potential harm of a nuclear accident.
