In a memorandum dated October 31, 2000, the Director, Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards specified the approval authority for actions within the Office. The memorandum also identified authority that could be redelegated in writing. As authorized by the Office Director, the Chief, Decommissioning Branch shall have the authority to take the following actions:

- Deny license amendments
- Issue, renew, amend, and terminate Byproduct, Source, and Special Nuclear Material Licenses. The termination of a license for a site on the Site Decommissioning Management Plan requires Commission notification and negative consent.

As appropriate, any proposed action which may have broad programmatic, public health and safety, or public interest potential may need to be raised to higher levels of management prior to taking the action.
