SUBJECT: DIRECT FINAL RULE TO REVISE THE 10 CFR PART 72 LIST

OF APPROVED SPENT FUEL STORAGE CASKS (HI-STAR 100,

AMENDMENT NUMBER 2)

Your concurrence is requested on the attached direct final rule and associated proposed rule that will revise the List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks (10 CFR 72.214). The staff is amending its regulations containing the list of approved spent fuel storage cask designs to indicate a revision to the Holtec International HI-STAR 100 cask system.

The cask, when used in accordance with the conditions specified in the revised CoC and NRC regulations, will meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 72; thus, adequate protection of public health and safety would be ensured. The cask amendment will allow holders of power reactor operating licensees to store spent fuel in the cask under the revised conditions. Amendment No. 2 to the HI-STAR 100 CoC would modify the cask design Appendix B of the Technical Specifications, Item 1.4.6, "Specific Parameters and Analysis for the Storage Pad and Foundation," to simplify the language of this specification. The current 60 g limit for cask drop and tipover events in Item 1.4.6 would remain unchanged

Since this rulemaking is about one amendment to the HI-STAR 100 cask system which is generally accepted by the staff as being "noncontroversial", we are using the direct final rule approach to shorten the time before the rule becomes effective.
