SUBJECT: DIRECT FINAL RULE TO AMEND 10 CFR 72.214 LIST OF

APPROVED SPENT FUEL STORAGE CASKS (HI-STAR 100,

AMENDMENT NUMBER 2)

Attached for your signature is a direct final rule along with the companion proposed rule (Attachments 1 and 2) amending U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission regulations, by revising the cask system listing for the Holtec International HI-STAR 100. Amendment No. 2 to the HI-STAR 100 CoC would modify the cask design Appendix B of the Technical Specifications, Item 1.4.6, "Specific Parameters and Analysis for the Storage Pad and Foundation" to simplify the language of this specification. The current 60-g limit for cask drop and tipover events in Item 1.4.6 would remain unchanged. The Commission directed the staff in a Staff Requirements Memorandum dated September 3, 1998, to use a direct final rule approach for CoC rulemakings. This amendment is considered to be noncontroversial because it only amends a previously approved cask system. Therefore, we are using the direct final rule approach to simplify the process and to shorten the time before the rule becomes effective.

<u>Notices</u>: Notices to the Commission that the Executive Director for Operations has signed the Federal Register notices are included for the Daily Staff Notes and Weekly Report to the Commission (Attachment 3 and 4 respectively). The Approved for Publication, the Environmental Assessment, and the SBREFA forms can be found in, respectively, Attachments 5 through 7 of this paper.
