Dear Mr. Plunkett:

The NRC staff has reviewed Florida Power and Light Company's (FPL's) environmental report (ER), submitted as part of the application for license renewal for Turkey Point Units 3 and 4. The staff has not identified the need for formal requests for additional information (RAIs) at this time. However, there are several topics still under discussion among our staffs. These include: updates of information presented in the ER; demographic information on FPL employees; information on contractor training regarding threatened and endangered species; information concerning well monitoring data from previous hydrologic studies; information on transmission rights-of-way characterization and maintenance activities; and information regarding the computer code used to determine shock hazard from electromagnetic fields.

We will continue to discuss these topics during our preparation of a draft Turkey-Point-specific supplement to the Generic Environmental Impact Statement and look forward to your support in order to support an accelerated review schedule.
