Dear Mr. Bermudez:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation earlier today regarding the relocation of our nuclear medicine dose calibrator, I would like to document that Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital will abide by Regulatory Guide 10.8, Appendix C, which outlines a model procedure following repair, adjustment, or relocation of a dose calibrator.

However, as a one-time exemption, I would like to request that the linearity test, which is to be performed as part of the model procedure, be delayed until the first opportunity following relocation of our dose calibrator (the previous linearity test was conducted on 1/22/01). During the period in which the linearity test is being performed, CCMH will use only isotopes less than 30 millicuries. A full test of the dose calibrator will be completed by no later than Monday, February 5, 2001.
