This is to inform you that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has approved an approach for addressing the use of Atomic Energy Act materials on Indian land which generally presumes Federal jurisdiction. As specific cases arise, we will work with individual Agreement States and other involved Stakeholders to resolve questions concerning Indian Land jurisdiction. This policy is contained in NUREG-1556, Volume 19 "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses" (re: Jurisdiction\Reciprocity) which was recently issued. This document will soon be available on the Internet at the following address: http://www.nrc.gov/NRC/NUREGS/SR1556/V19/index.html. You will recall that a draft of this document was provided to you for review and comment by All Agreement States letter STP-00-069, dated August 16, 2000. The implementing details of this policy will be contained in the forthcoming STP Procedure SA-500, "Jurisdiction Determinations." We will work with individual Agreement State and other involved Stakeholders to resolve questions on American Indian Land jurisdiction, as specific cases arise.
