The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) intends to publish a proposed rule in the <u>Federal Register</u> that would amend the material control and accounting (MC&A) requirements for special nuclear material. NRC is proposing to revise the submittal date for the Material Balance Reports and the Inventory Composition Reports to provide more flexibility for licensees and to reduce the number of reports. The proposed rule would relocate the remaining MC&A requirements in 10 CFR Part 70 to 10 CFR Part 74. The proposed rule would make the MC&A requirements for facilities that possess special nuclear material of moderate significance more risk-informed. The proposed rule would also revise the categorical exclusion that covers approval of safeguards plans to include amendments of those plans, correct some typographical errors, delete old implementation dates, and clarify and add some definitions to Part 74.
