SUBJECT: INSPECTION 50-346/00201 (OPERATIONAL SAFEGUARDS RESPONSE EVALUATION)

Dear Mr. Campbell:

During March 6 to 9, 2000, the NRC's Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation performed an Operational Safeguards Response Evaluation (OSRE) at the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station. A final exit meeting was held by telephone conference on June 22, 2000, to summarize the findings of the OSRE. The enclosed report presents the scope and results of that inspection.

The primary purpose of the OSRE was to assess your ability to respond to an external threat. The OSRE also assessed the interaction between operations and security in establishing priorities for protection of equipment and the protective strategies used. The OSRE included a safety/safeguards interface review to ensure that safeguards measures did not adversely impact safe operation of the facility.

The protective strategy employed by the licensee security force indicated an effective overall contingency response capability. The OSRE team noted significant operations involvement in the planning and exercising of the contingency response capability and concluded that the protective strategy for Davis-Besse was being effectively implemented and that the response force was capable of protecting public health and safety against the NRC design basis threat. The team also concluded that effective provisions were in place to ensure that safeguards measures did not adversely affect the safe operations of the facility.


