I. SECY-89-223 - Motion by Joseph J Macktal fro Disqualifi-
cation of Commissioners fro further Consideration of
Matters Relating to Him

The Commission, by a 4-0 vote, approved and order in response to
a motion by Mr. Joseph J. Macktal for disqualification of
Commissioners from all future issues involving himself. The
order denied the motion.

(Subsequently, on August 16,1989, the Secretary signed the
order.)

II. SECY-89-232 - Order Denying Hearing Request, Petition to
Intervene in Limerick Remand Proceeding, and Request for
Stay of Low-Power Operation of Limerick Unit 2

The Commission, by a 4-0 vote, approved and order responding to
a petition, submitted by Mr. Robert Anthony, in which he
requested "to be continued as an intervenor in the licensing
process for [Limerick] Unit 2" and for a stay of low-power
authorization. The order denied the request.

(subsequently, on August 16, 1989, the Secretary signed the
order.)

III. SECY-89-234 - Response to Limerick Ecology Action's

Motion for Reconsideration

The commission, by a 4-0 vote, approved and order responding to a July 14, 1989, motion by Limerick Ecology Action (LEA), which

requested that the Commission "reconsider, stay, suspend, or revoke" its order of July 7, 1989 (CLI 89-10), which concluded that issuance of the low-power license of Limerick Unit 1 was not preclude by the U.S. Court of Appeals decision in Limerick Ecology Action, Inc. v. NRC. The order denied the request.

(subsequently, on August 16, 1989, the Secretary signed the order.)

IV. SECY-89-243 - Morabito Request for Reconsideration

The Commission, by a 4-0 vote, approved an order responding to and August 12, 1988, request by Alfred J. Morabito, that the Commission reconsider its July 15, 1988, determination that he was ineligible for a senior operator license because he had taken employment outside the nuclear area. The order denied the request.
