Dear Ms. Barber:

Thank you for helping me obtain the information from my FOIA request of September 16, 2000. Your letter suggests that I received a final answer from Carol Ann Reed on October 19, 2000. This is not the case. The only communication I received from Ms. Reed was dated September 18, 2000 and it consisted of a cover letter, a FOIA receipt, an explanation of fees, and information regarding a fee waiver. Your letter of January 24, 2001 was the first notification I received that my information request was answered and available. I was able to download the information from ADAMS, but I find working with ADAMS extremely difficult.

Your letter suggests that I received an e-mail response from Mr. Robert Jasinski dated September 14, 2000. This also is not the case. I have rechecked my e-mail logs and there is no indication that I received Mr. Jasinski's response. I would appreciate it if you would send me a hard copy of Mr. Jasinski's e-mail response of September 14, 2000.

I was alarmed by the statements in your letter from Ms. Reed that the NRC does not possess the information used to compute the aircraft crash frequency. I am concerned that the NRC submitted an approval to the Air Force's Final SEIS for the air base disposal without being able to

verify the aircraft crash frequency into the Turkey Point Nuclear Power Plant. I question whether the inability of the NRC to duplicate the safety calculations meets NEPA requirements or whether it ensures the health and safety of the public.
