The Commission was briefed by the Georgia Power Company (applicant) and the staff on the applicant's readiness to receive a full power operating license for the Vogtle Electric Generating Plant, unit 2.

The Commission, with all Commissioners agreeing, authorized the staff to issue, upon finding that the licensee has satisfied all requirements, a full power operating license to Georgia Power Company for the Vogtle Electric Generating Plant, Unit 2.

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In a separate vote, the Commission, with all Commissioners agreeing, authorized the staff, as part of its licensing process, to consider as final the finding of "no significant antitrust changes" made by the Director, Office of Nuclear

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Reactor Regulation. This completes Commission action on SECY-89-096 an Information paper, entitled "Finding of 'No Significant Change' Pursuant to the operating License Antitrust Review of Plant Vogtle, Unit 2".
