On February 7, 2001, the House Energy and Commerce Committee met to organize for the 107th Congress. They approved the attached Republican and Democratic Subcommittee assignments.

Committee Chairman W.J. "Billy" Tauzin (LA) and Ranking Minority Member John Dingell (MI) announced the assignments. Chairman Tauzin said this is a new and "energized" Energy and Commerce Committee with an immense agenda. He said he wants to do business on time and stressed the need for bipartisan support in order to get things done. However, Congressman Dingell said that there has not been much bipartisanship since the beginning of the 107th Congress and complained that the Minority has been denied their fair share of Members on the Committee. He provided a chart that indicated a fairer split when the Democrats were in the majority.

Chairman Tauzin said that they will announce an oversight plan next week.
