Dear Mr. Lundvall:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment Nos. 81 and 64 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-53 and DPR-69 for the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2, in response to your submittal of August 17, and application dated October 7, 1982.

The amendments modify License Nos. DPR-53 and DPR-69 to incorporate the most recent revisions to the Physical Security Plan.

The amendments apply to the Physical Security Plan. They do not authorize a change in effluent types or total amounts nor an increase in power level, and will not result in any significant environmental impact. Having made this determination, we have further concluded that these amendments involve an action which is insignificant from the standpoint of environmental impact and pursuant to 10 CFR 51.5(d)(4) that an environmental impact statement, or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of the amendments.

In addition, these amendments do not involve significant new safety information of a type not considered by a previous Commission safety review of the facility. They do not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously evaluated, do not create the possibility of an accident of a type different from any evaluated previously, do not involve a significant decrease in a margin of safety, and therefore, do not involve a significant hazards consideration. We have also concluded that there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by this action and that the issuance of the amendments will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public.

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
 - A. The filing by Baltimore Gas & Electric Company (the licensee) dated August 17 and the application dated October 7, 1982 comply with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
 - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the filings, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
 - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
 - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
 - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
2. Accordingly, Paragraphs 2.C.(4) and 2.C.(4)a of Facility Operating License No. DPR-53 are hereby amended to read as follows:


2.C.(4) Physical Protection

The licensee shall fully implement and maintain in effect all provisions of the following Commission-approved documents, including amendments and changes made pursuant to the authority of 10 CFR 50.54(p). These approved documents consist of information withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 73.21.

- a. "Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Units Nos. 1 and 2 Physical Security Plan," dated February 10, 1978, as revised through Revision 10 dated August 17, 1982 and supplemented by letter dated October 7, 1982.

3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance.

2. Accordingly, Paragraphs 2.D and 2.D.(1) of Facility Operating License No. DPR-69 are hereby amended to read as follows:


2.D. Physical Protection

OPERATING LICENSES

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment Nos. 81 and 64 to Facility Operating Licenses Nos. DPR-53 and DPR-69, issued to Baltimore Gas & Electric Company (the licensee), which revised the licenses for operation of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2 (the facility), located in Calvert County, Maryland. The amendments are effective as of the date of issuance.

The amendments modify license conditions to incorporate the most recent revisions to the Physical Security Plan.

The licensee's filings comply with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendments. Prior public notice of these amendments was not required since the amendments do not involve a significant hazards consideration.

The Commission has determined that the issuance of these amendments will not result in any significant environmental impact and that pursuant to 10 CFR §51.5(d)(4) an environmental impact statement or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with issuance of the amendments.


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The licensee's filings dated August 17 and October 7, 1982 are being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 73.21.
