SUBJECT: REVIEW OF NRC ENFORCEMENT POLICY AND FINAL  
RULE ON REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN GENERALLY  
LICENSED INDUSTRIAL DEVICES CONTAINING  
BYPRODUCT MATERIAL (10 CFR PARTS 30, 31, 32,  
170, AND 171)

The Rules and Directives Branch has reviewed and concurs, subject to our markup, on the rulemaking package that would amend the regulations governing the use of byproduct material in certain detecting, measuring, gauging, or controlling devices, and devices to produce light or an ionized atmosphere. We have attached a marked copy of the package that presents our comments.

A Regulatory History must be created for this final rule once it has been published in the Federal Register. The Regulatory History should be created in ADAMS. In the profile of each document related to the Regulatory History, use the Regulation Identifier Number (RIN) as the Case/Reference Number (RIN-AG03). This will make it easier to combine all the documents into a package under ADAMS once the final rule has been published.
