SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT

By application dated November 13, 2000, Framatome Cogema Fuels (FCF) requested an amendment to Certificate of Compliance No. 6206 for the Model B package. FCF proposed changing the certificate holder from FCF to Framatome ANP, Inc. This change is necessary due to the merger of the world-wide nuclear business of FCF's ultimate parent company (Framatome S.A.) with the world-wide nuclear business of Siemens AG. This merger and other associated transactions will result in the dissolution of FCF. The new company that will include the former business of FCF will be called Framatome ANP, Inc.

NRC Information Notice 89-25, Revision 1, Attachment 1, "Information Needed for Change of Ownership Application," dated December 7, 1994, provides a list of information applicants should provide to the NRC when requesting a change of ownership or control. In FCF's application, all of the information requested in the Information Notice was provided. This information included statements that the merger and other associated transactions would not result in any significant change in the management or technical personnel responsible for licensed activities, including nuclear safety, and that the current safety and licensing organizations would remain unchanged. In addition, by letter dated February 9, 2001, the applicant notified NRC that the name change from Framatome Cogema Fuels to Framatome ANP, Inc. was effective as of January 1, 2001, and the associated merger activities were concluded on January 31, 2001. On the basis of this information, the staff has determined that the proposed amendment to the Certificate of Compliance is acceptable.

As requested by the applicant, Certificate of Compliance No. 6206, for the Model B package, has been amended to list Framatome ANP, Inc., as the certificate holder. This change does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
