of and reflecting this Order, must be issued and become effective as of the date of issuance; (2) should the transfer of the licenses not be consummated by December 31, 1997, this Order shall become null and void, provided, however, on application and for good cause shown, such date may be extended.

IV.

By December 4, 1996, any person adversely affected by this Order may file a request for a hearing with respect to issuance of the Order. Any person requesting a hearing shall set forth with particularity how such person's interest is adversely affected by this Order and shall address the criteria set forth in 10 CFR 2.714(d).

If a hearing is to be held, the Commission will issue an Order designating the time and place of such hearing.

The issue to be considered at any such hearing will be whether this Order should be sustained.

On November 4, 1996 (61 FR 56714), the Federal Register published the Baltimore Gas and Electric Company; (Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2 and the Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation); Order Approving Transfer of Licenses for Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2 and the Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation. On page 56714, under Section IV, the date by which a hearing request may be filed was inadvertently omitted. Section IV, paragraph 1 should read as follows: By December 4, 1996, any person adversely affected by this Order may file a request for a hearing with respect to issuance of the Order. Any person requesting a hearing shall set forth with particularity how such person's interest is adversely affected by this Order and shall address the criteria set forth in 10 CFR 2.714(d).
